BURLEY WOODHEAD ILKLEY**

**PUBLIC FOOTPATH (EXTINGUISHMENT) ORDER 2018**

On 7th October 2021, The Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council confirmed the above Order made under section 118B of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish that part of Public Footpath No. 65 (Ilkley) as shown by a continuous bold black line on plan no. 66666/T236/Order Plan annexed to this Order. It forms part of the Public Footpath No. 65 (Ilkley) extending between points marked A and B on the Order map continuing in a north easterly direction for 184 metres with a width of 1.2 metres and a surface of grass.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order map have been placed on the Council's website at <https://bradford.moderngov.co.uk/mgConsultationListDisplay.aspx> and Ilkley Library, Station Road, Ilkley LS29 8HA during normal office hours. Copies of the confirmed Order and map may be purchased.

The Order comes into force on 26th November 2021, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 14th October 2021 make an application to the High Court.

**PUBLIC PATH (EXTINGUISHMENT) ORDER 2018**

**THIS ORDER** is made by **CITY OF BRADFORD METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COUNCIL** (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) under Section 118B (4) of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the Council that as respects the relevant highway described in Article 1 below (“the highway”) –

- (a) the Council are the highway authority for the area;
- (b) the highway crosses land occupied for the purposes of a school; and
- (c) it is expedient, for the purpose of protecting the pupils or staff from –
  - (i) violence or threat of violence,
  - (ii) harassment
  - (iii) alarm or distress arising from unlawful activity, or
  - (iv) any other risk to their health or safety arising from such activity,

that the highway should be stopped up.

The police authority, West Yorkshire Police, for the area in which the highway lies has been consulted as required by section 118B(6) of the 1980 Act.

The City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council have consented to the making of Order as required by section 120(2)(a) of the 1980 Act

**BY THIS ORDER:**

- 1 The public right of way over the land situated between Sandholme Drive and Public Footpath No. 65/65A (Ilkley), Burley Woodhead, Ilkley, West Yorkshire

shown by a continuous bold line on the map attached to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.

2. WHERE immediately before the date of confirmation of this Order there is apparatus under, in, on, along or across the footpath referred to in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto, belonging to statutory undertakers for the purposes of carrying on their undertakings the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
3. THIS Order may be cited as the "City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council Public Footpath No. 65 (Ilkley)(Part) between Sandholme Drive and Public Footpath No. 65/65A (Ilkley), Burley Woodhead, Ilkley (Public Footpath (Extinguishment) Order) 2018".

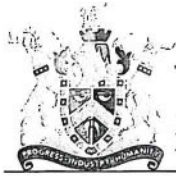
## **SCHEDULE**

### Description of site of existing path or way to be extinguished

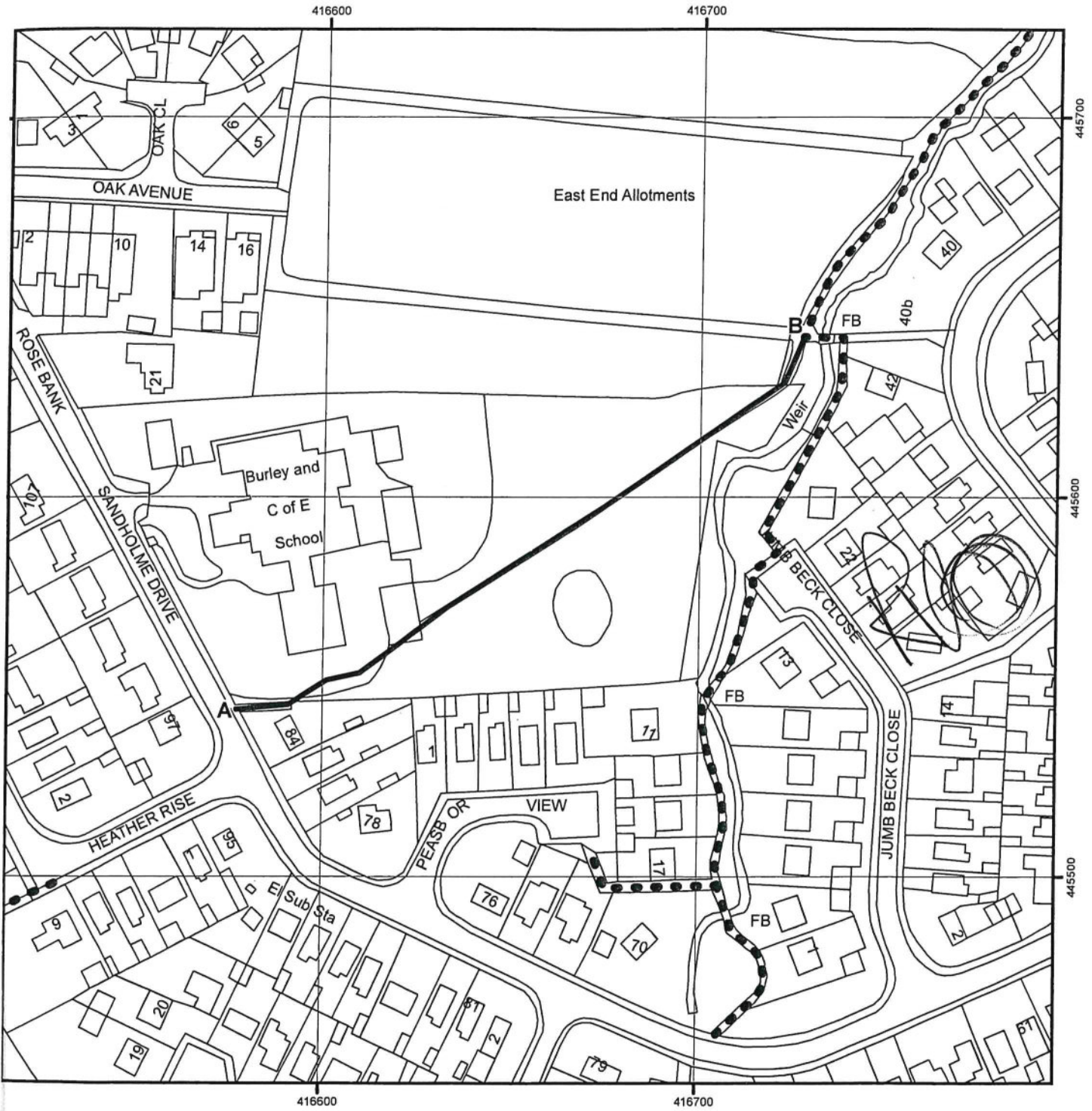
1. That part of Public Footpath No 65 (Ilkley) in the former County Borough of Bradford as shown by a continuous bold black line on the map annexed hereto, commencing at Point A on the attached plan and continuing in a north easterly direction for approximately 184 metres with a width of approximately 1.2 metres and a surface of grass to Point B on the attached plan being part of Public Footpath No. 65 (Ilkley).

The grid references are; Point A - SE 165 455, Point B - SE 167 456

All distances are measured on the map.




