PROPOSED CHANGES OF THE HACKNEY CARRIAGE TABLE OF FARES

## **Summary statement:**

A request was submitted on the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2022 by the Hackney Carriage Owners and Drivers Trade Association and the Hackney Carriage Trade Association, to increase the fare charged to the customer by increasing the charge for the distance.

The fare for Hackney Carriages was last increased on the 1<sup>st</sup> December 2021, this was the first increase in some 10 years. This is therefore an unusual request for a further increase resulting from the sudden upsurge in Fuel Costs.

#### 1. SUMMARY

Unlike the Private Hire Trade who can set or change their fares without Council approval, the Council is responsible for setting fares for Hackney Carriage Vehicles. This is a requirement of Section 65 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.

Hackney Carriage Drivers must not charge more than the fare as displayed on their Taxi meter.

Hackney Carriage Proprietors and Drivers may submit a request to the Licensing Service for a variation to the Table of Fares, as a way to increase the fare charged to the customer.

## 2. BACKGROUND

A request was submitted on the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2022 by the Hackney Carriage Owners and Drivers Trade Association and the Hackney Carriage Trade Association, to increase the fare charged to the customer by increasing the charge for the distance.

#### 3. OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

The fare for Hackney Carriages was last increased on the 1<sup>st</sup> December 2021, this was the first increase in some 10 years. This is therefore an unusually sudden request for a further increase resulting from the rapid recent upsurge in Fuel Costs.

Following the upsurge in Fuel costs many Private Hire Companies have increased their fare for the 1<sup>st</sup> mile travelled. Private Hire Companies are able to do this without the approval from the Council.

#### 4. FINANCIAL & RESOURCE APPRAISAL

This change request is for:-

- 1. Hackney Carriages to charge an additional 50p on the initial fare on tariffs 1 and 2
- 2. Hackney Carriages to charge an additional 10p for each minute of waiting time on tariffs 2 and 3

The advert was printed in the Telegraph and Argus news paper on the 7<sup>th</sup> August 2022.

Details of any objection or comment submitted by the public will be produced for consideration at the Regulatory and Appeals Meeting on the 21<sup>st</sup> August 2022, exactly 14 Days from the date of print.
