

Annex 2 – Conditions Consistent with Operating Schedule

All four Licensing Objectives:

None

The Prevention of Crime & Disorder:

1. All existing external security lighting shall be maintained in good working order and used where appropriate at all times the premises remain open to the public.
2. The existing CCTV System installed at the premises shall be maintained in good working order and used at all times the premises remain open to the public for licensable activities. Any CCTV footage shall be kept for at least 28 days and available to the Licensing Authority or a Responsible Authority on request.
3. The Licensee will ensure close liaison with other licensees in the area and will co-operate with any local "Pub Watch" schemes or similar schemes being promoted by West Yorkshire Police or other local Licensees.
4. All staff (including temporary staff) employed shall be adequately trained in good customer safety, customer care, compliance with the law and child protection issues.
5. The Licensee shall maintain working arrangements with local taxi/private hire operators and take reasonable steps to communicate this to patrons in order to ensure orderly booking, arrival and departure of customers in such vehicles.

Public Safety:

6. All emergency lighting; illuminated fire exit signs; fire fighting equipment; fire alarm (including the music system cut off device) and first aid facilities shall be maintained in good working order and all staff, including temporary staff, adequately trained in their use.
7. The Licensee shall provide a plan of the premises to the Licensing Authority and West Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Service, detailing the location and type of all fire safety and other safety equipment, including fire alarms, emergency lighting, fire extinguishers, fire doors and notices, to the satisfaction of West Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Service.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance:

8. Removal of refuse and emptying of bottle bins within the curtilage of the licensed premises shall not take place between the hours of 21.00 and 07.00.

The Protection of Children from Harm:

9. The Licensee and staff must ensure that children under 18 years of age vacate the premises by 19.00 hours.

10. Children accompanied by a parent or guardian shall only be allowed in seated areas within the premises and shall not be allowed access to the bar area; cigarette machines; or amusement with prizes machines.
11. The Licensee shall enforce an efficient recognised “proof of age policy” at all times and ensure appropriate staffing training in its operation.
12. No regulated entertainment of an adult or sexual nature shall be provided at any time in the licensed premises.

Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the Licensing Authority

13. The outdoor areas are to be wholly cleared of customers and apparatus no later than 23.20 hours and appropriate signage displayed encouraging patrons to cooperate with this requirement.
14. Removal of rubbish and emptying of bottle bins shall be restricted between 09.00 and 19.00 hours only.
