**VARIOUS SCHOOL STREETS TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2022**

Notice is hereby given that City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council made the following Orders on 13<sup>th</sup> December 2022 under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of vehicles within the stated time periods on the following lengths of road: -

- 1. City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council High Crag Primary Leadership Academy (Pratt Lane, Shipley) School Street Traffic Regulation Order 2022**  
Pratt Lane, Shipley from its junction with Prospect Street to its western termination point and including the southern spur serving nos. 5-19. Kitson Street, in its entirety between 8:30am – 9:15am and 3:00pm – 3:30 pm from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> July;
- 2. City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council Shipley C of E Primary School (Otley Road, Shipley) School Street Traffic Regulation Order 2022**  
Unnamed back street to the south of Birklands Road, in its entirety, Castle Road from its junction with Birklands Road to its southern termination point between 8:35am – 9:15am and 2:45pm – 3:40 pm from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> July;
- 3. City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council Westminster C of E Primary Academy (Westminster Road, Bradford) School Street Traffic Regulation Order 2022**  
Westminster Road, Bradford from its junction with Westminster Terrace to its northern termination point. Westminster Place in its entirety. 2 no. unnamed back streets, between their junctions with Westminster Road and their terminations. 1no. unnamed back street, between its junction with Westminster Terrace and its termination, Northallerton Road, from a point 12m west of its junction with Sunnyside Lane to its western termination point between 8:10am – 8:30am and 2:45pm – 3:15pm from 1st September to 31st July; and
- 4. City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council Girington Primary School (Kensington Street, Bradford) School Streets Traffic Regulation Order 2022**  
Kensington Street from its junction with Thorn Street to its junction with Birch Street between 8:40am-9:20am and 2:40pm-3:35pm.

If you wish to question the validity of the Orders, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any Instrument made under it, have not been complied with in relation to the Orders, you may, within six weeks from the date upon which the Orders were made on 13<sup>th</sup> December 2022 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

#### SCHOOL STREET TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022

The City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984" and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 "the Act of 2004" and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:

#### PART 1 GENERAL

##### Citation and commencement

1. This Order is made on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 2022 and shall come into operation on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2022 and shall be cited as "City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council Westminster C of E Primary School (Westminster Road, Bradford) School Street Traffic Regulation Order 2022".

##### Interpretation

3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.
4. Where a provision of this Order is in conflict with a provision contained in a previous order, the provisions of this Order shall prevail for the period that this Order is in force.
5. Where a statute, statutory instrument, specification or regulation is referred to such reference shall include an amendment to or replacement thereof.
6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, regulation or other requirement imposed by law.
7. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it. The lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order are shown for illustrative purposes only on drawing number: - PTH/HS/104491/WPS01annexed hereto.

##### Definitions

8. In this Order, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"Bus" has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"Contractual Vehicle" means a bus, Licensed Hire Vehicle, Licensed Taxi or Hackney Carriage contracted by the Council and/or school to take children to or from a school, fronting or adjacent to a Restricted Road;

"Council" means the City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council and includes any contractors or authorised agents appointed by or acting on behalf of the Council for the purposes of any function under the provisions of this Order;

"Exempt Vehicle" means the following;

- a. any Motor Vehicle being driven by a care worker, healthcare professional or social worker required to visit any dwelling fronting onto or adjacent to a Restricted Road in the course of their employment;
- b. any bus, Licensed Hire Vehicle, Licensed Taxi or Hackney Carriage entering the Restricted Road for the sole purpose of picking up or dropping off an occupant of a dwelling fronting onto or adjacent to a Restricted Road;
- c. any Motor Vehicle entering the Restricted Road for the sole purpose of making a collection or delivery to or from a dwelling fronting onto or adjacent to a Restricted Road in the course of business; and
- d. any Motor Vehicle displaying a valid Blue Badge entering a Restricted Road for the purposes of either picking up or dropping off a Blue Badge holder.

“Hackney Carriage” means a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 (for the avoidance of doubt this does not include a private hire vehicle within the meaning of Section 80 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

“Licensed Hire Vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 13 of the Transport Act 1985;

“Licensed Taxi” has the same meaning as in Section 13 of the Transport Act 1985;

“Motor Vehicle” has the same meaning as that in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“Private Hire Vehicle” has the same meaning as that in Section 80 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

“Restricted Road” means any Road or part of a Road specified in Schedule 1 to therein in which access is restricted to time and/or place and/or day in accordance with the provisions of this Order;

“Road” has the same meaning as that in Section 142 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“School Street Exemption Permit” means a permit issued by the Council in respect of a Motor Vehicle owned and registered to a resident of a Restricted Road.

“Undertaker” has the same meaning as that in Section 48 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991.

## **PART 2 PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

9. Save as hereinafter provided, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in the length of Road specified in the Schedule to this Order Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays and public holidays in England) 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> July other than:

- a) a Motor Vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- b) a Motor Vehicle (if it cannot reasonably be used for the same purpose in any other Road) being used in connection with any of the following operations in an emergency: building works; the removal of any obstruction to traffic; the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Road; the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the Road by an Undertaker of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus;

- c) a Motor Vehicle displaying a valid School Street Exemption Permit issued in respect of that Restricted Road;
- d) Contractual Vehicles.
- e) Exempt Vehicles.

**PART 3 MODIFICATIONS**

10. This Order includes provision for the Council’s Planning, Transportation & Highways Assistant Director, or person authorised by the aforementioned officer, to modify or suspend this Order or any provision of it if it appears to them essential:

- a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic,
- b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities, or
- c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs.

11. The power in Article 10 shall not include making additions to the Order and shall be exercised only after consulting the appropriate Chief Officer of Police and giving such notice as the Secretary of State may direct.

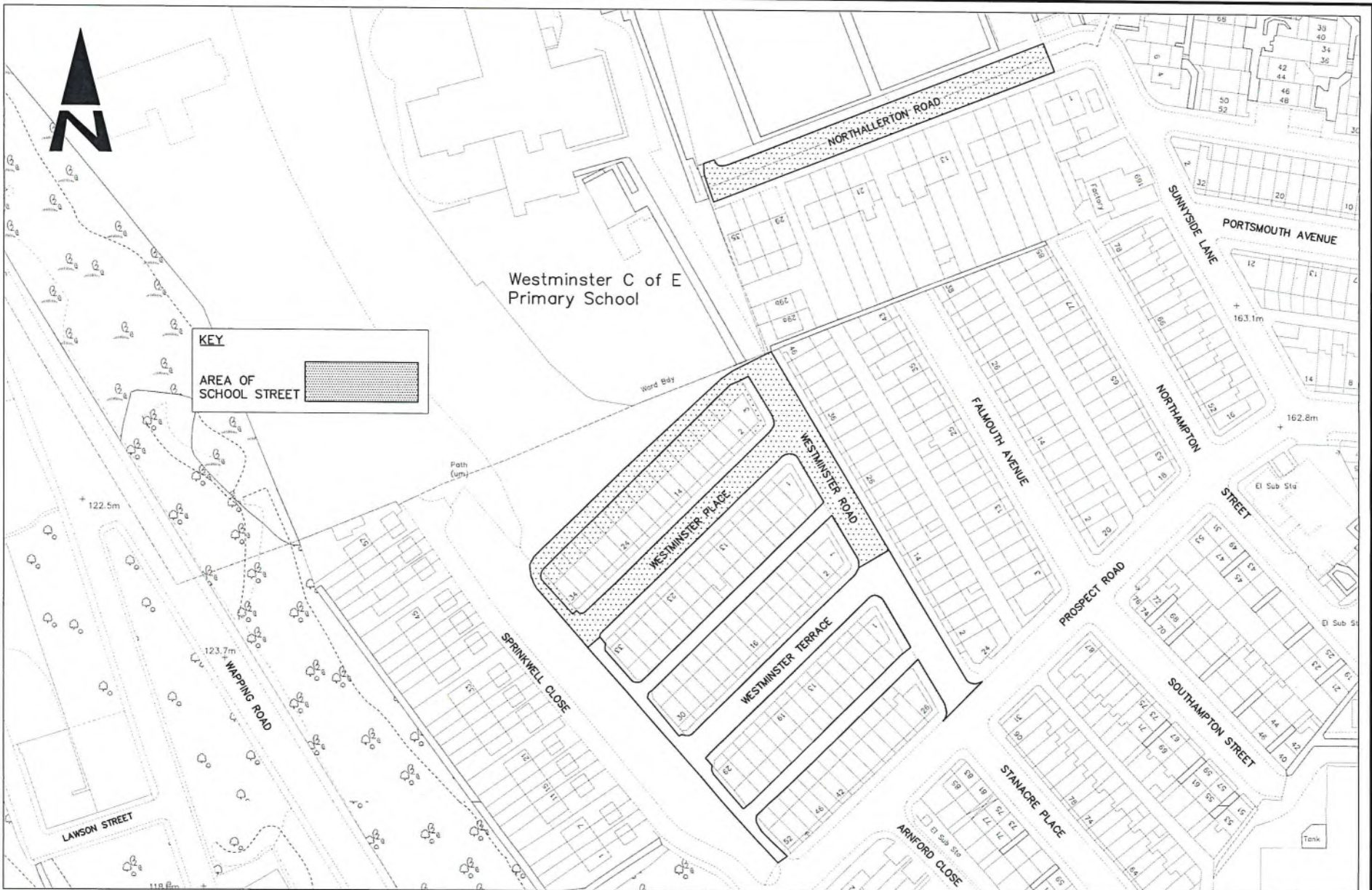



- c. any Motor Vehicle entering the Restricted Road for the sole purpose of making a collection or delivery to or from a dwelling fronting onto or adjacent to a Restricted Road in the course of business.
- d. any Motor Vehicle displaying a valid Blue Badge entering a Restricted Road for the purposes of either picking up or dropping off a Blue Badge holder.

“Hackney Carriage” means a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 (for the avoidance of doubt this does not include a private hire vehicle within the meaning of Section 80 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

“Licensed Hire Vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 13 of the Transport Act 1985;

“Licensed Taxi” has the same meaning as in Section 13 of the Transport Act 1985;

“Motor Vehicle” has the same meaning as that in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“Private Hire Vehicle” has the same meaning as that in Section 80 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

Save as hereinafter provided, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in the length of Road specified in the Schedule to this Order Monday to Friday (Excluding Bank Holidays and Public Holidays in England) from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> July other than:

- a) a Motor Vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- b) a Motor Vehicle (if it cannot reasonably be used for the same purpose in any other Road) being used in connection with any of the following operations in an emergency: building works; the removal of any obstruction to traffic; the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Road; the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the Road by an Undertaker of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus;

c) a Motor Vehicle displaying a valid School Street Exemption Permit issued in respect of that Restricted Road;

d) Contractual Vehicles.

e) Exempt Vehicles.

### PART 3 MODIFICATIONS

10. This Order includes provision for the Council's Planning, Transportation & Highways Assistant Director, or person authorised by the aforementioned officer, to modify or suspend this Order or any provision of it if it appears to them essential:

a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic,

b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities, or

c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs.

11. The power in Article 10 shall not include making additions to the Order and shall be exercised only after consulting the appropriate Chief Officer of Police and giving such notice as the Secretary of State may direct.

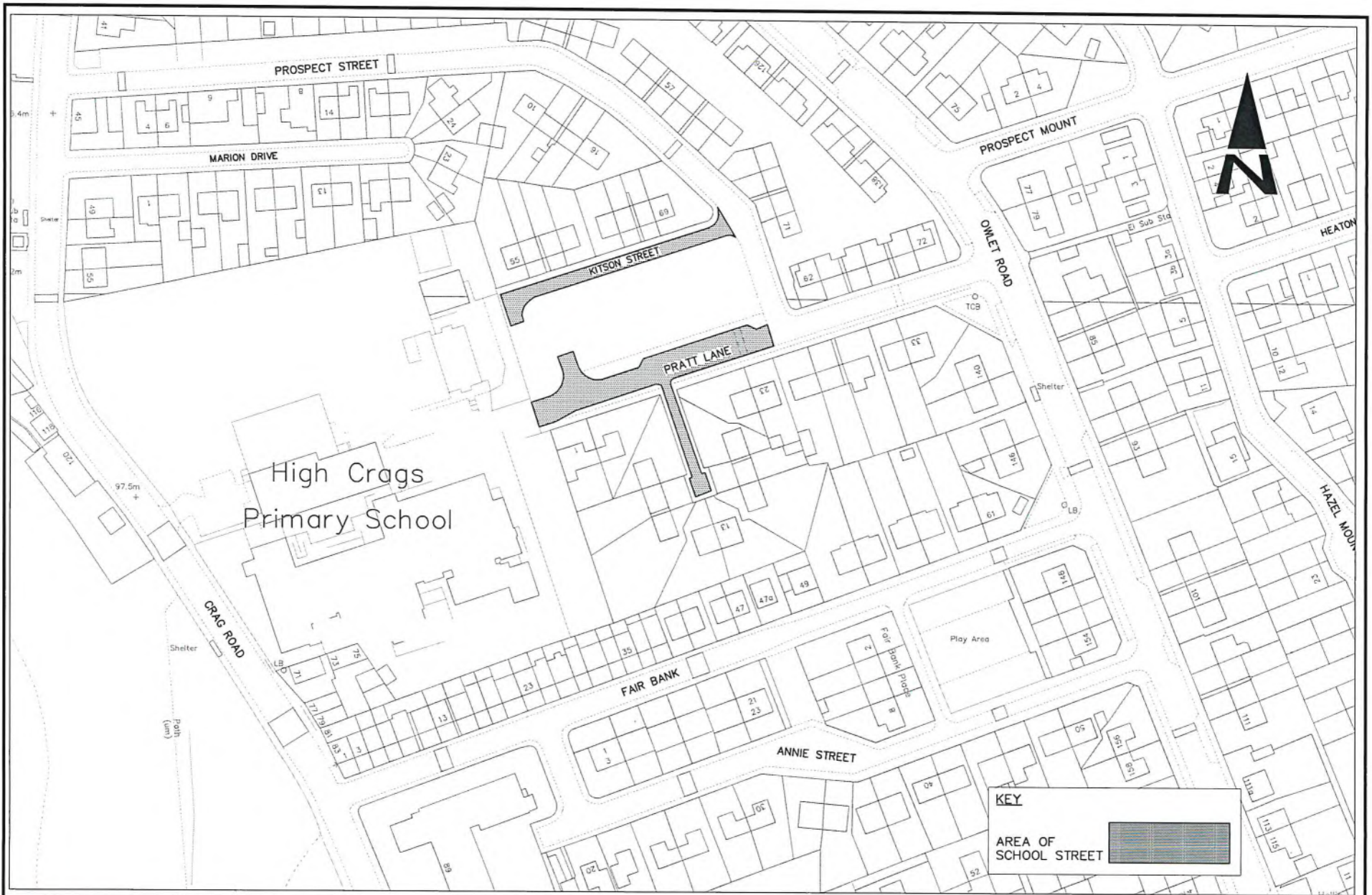

- a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic,
- b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities, or
- c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs.

11. The power in Article 10 shall not include making additions to the Order and shall be exercised only after consulting the appropriate Chief Officer of Police and giving such notice as the Secretary of State may direct.

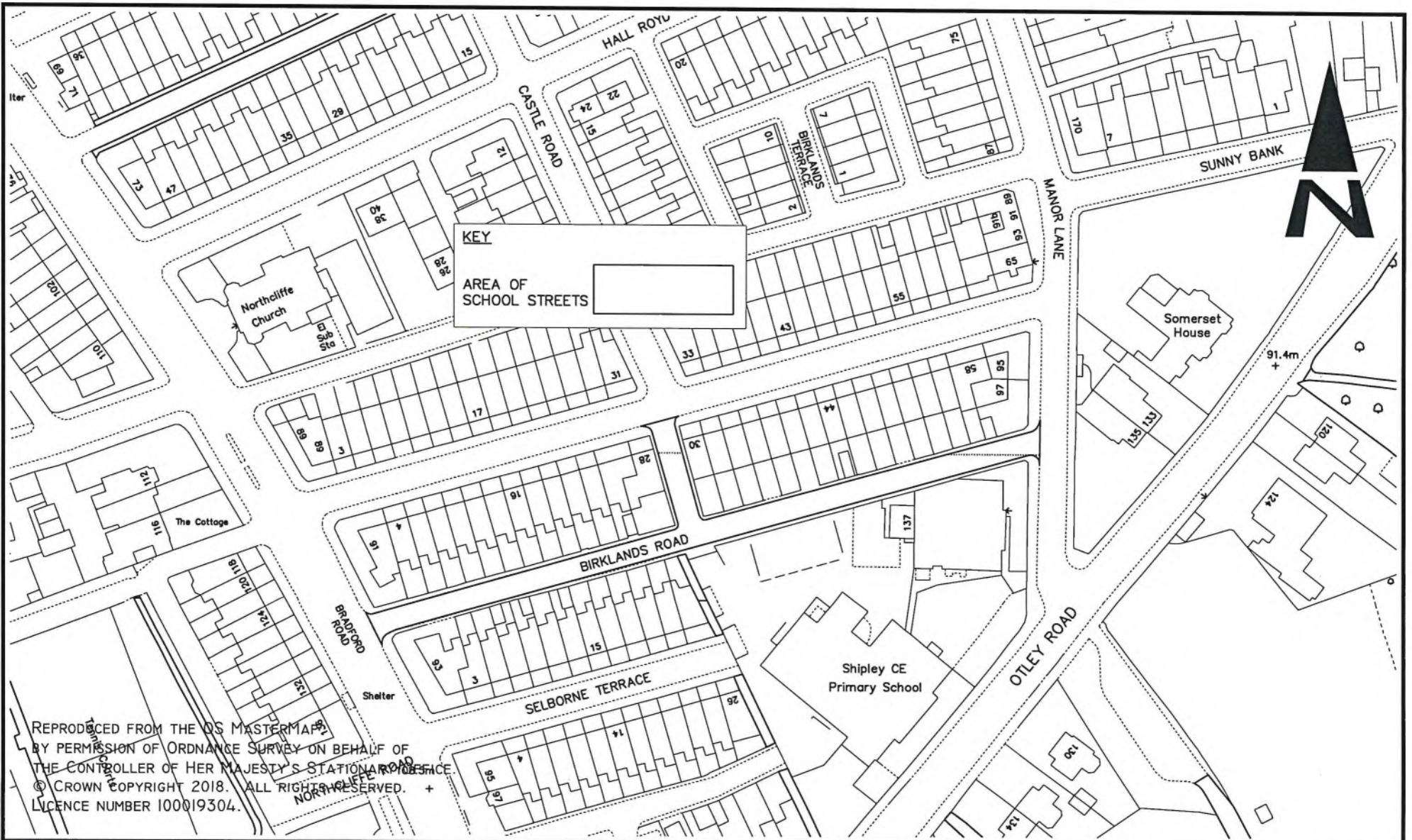

**SCHOOL STREETS TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**

The City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984" and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 "the Act of 2004" and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:

**PART 1 GENERAL**

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is made on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 2022 and shall come into operation on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2022 and shall be cited as "City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council Girlington Primary School (Kensington Street, Bradford) School Streets Traffic Regulation Order 2022".

**Interpretation**

3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.
4. Where a provision of this Order is in conflict with a provision contained in a previous order, the provisions of this Order shall prevail for the period that this Order is in force.
5. Where a statute, statutory instrument, specification or regulation is referred to such reference shall include an amendment to or replacement thereof.
6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, regulation or other requirement imposed by law.
7. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it. The lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order are shown for illustrative purposes only on drawing number: - PTH/HS/104491/GPS01 annexed hereto.

**Definitions**

8. In this Order, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"Bus" has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"Contractual Vehicle" means a bus, Licensed Hire Vehicle, Licensed Taxi or Hackney Carriage contracted by the Council and/or school to take children to or from a school, fronting or adjacent to a Restricted Road;

"Council" means the City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council and includes any contractors or authorised agents appointed by or acting on behalf of the Council for the purposes of any function under the provisions of this Order;

"Exempt Vehicle" means the following;



- a. any Motor Vehicle being driven by a care worker, healthcare professional or social worker required to visit any dwelling fronting onto or adjacent to a Restricted Road in the course of their employment;
- b. any bus, Licensed Hire Vehicle, Licensed Taxi or Hackney Carriage entering the Restricted Road for the sole purpose of picking up or dropping off an occupant of a dwelling fronting onto or adjacent to a Restricted Road;
- c. any Motor Vehicle entering the Restricted Road for the sole purpose of making a collection or delivery to or from a dwelling fronting onto or adjacent to a Restricted Road in the course of business; and
- d. any Motor Vehicle displaying a valid Blue Badge entering a Restricted Road for the purposes of either picking up or dropping off a Blue Badge holder.

“Hackney Carriage” means a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 (for the avoidance of doubt this does not include a private hire vehicle within the meaning of Section 80 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

“Licensed Hire Vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 13 of the Transport Act 1985;

“Licensed Taxi” has the same meaning as in Section 13 of the Transport Act 1985;

“Motor Vehicle” has the same meaning as that in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“Private Hire Vehicle” has the same meaning as that in Section 80 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

“Restricted Road” means any Road or part of a Road specified in Schedule 1 to therein in which access is restricted to time and/or place and/or day in accordance with the provisions of this Order;

“Road” has the same meaning as that in Section 142 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“School Street Exemption Permit” means a permit issued by the Council in respect of a Motor Vehicle owned and registered to a resident of a Restricted Road.

“Undertaker” has the same meaning as that in Section 48 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991.

## **PART 2 PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

9. Save as hereinafter provided, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in the length of Road specified in the Schedule to this Order Monday to Friday (Excluding Bank Holidays and Public Holidays in England) from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> July, other than:

- a) a Motor Vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- b) a Motor Vehicle (if it cannot reasonably be used for the same purpose in any other Road) being used in connection with any of the following operations in an emergency: building works; the removal of any obstruction to traffic; the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Road; the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the Road by an Undertaker of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus;

- c) a Motor Vehicle displaying a valid School Street Exemption Permit issued in respect of that Restricted Road;
- d) Contractual Vehicles;
- e) Exempt Vehicles; and
- f) Vehicles accessing The Women's Centre.

**PART 3 MODIFICATIONS**

10. This Order includes provision for the Council's Planning, Transportation & Highways Assistant Director, or person authorised by the aforementioned officer, to modify or suspend this Order or any provision of it if it appears to them essential:

- a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic,
- b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities, or
- c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs.

11. The power in Article 10 shall not include making additions to the Order and shall be exercised only after consulting the appropriate Chief Officer of Police and giving such notice as the Secretary of State may direct.

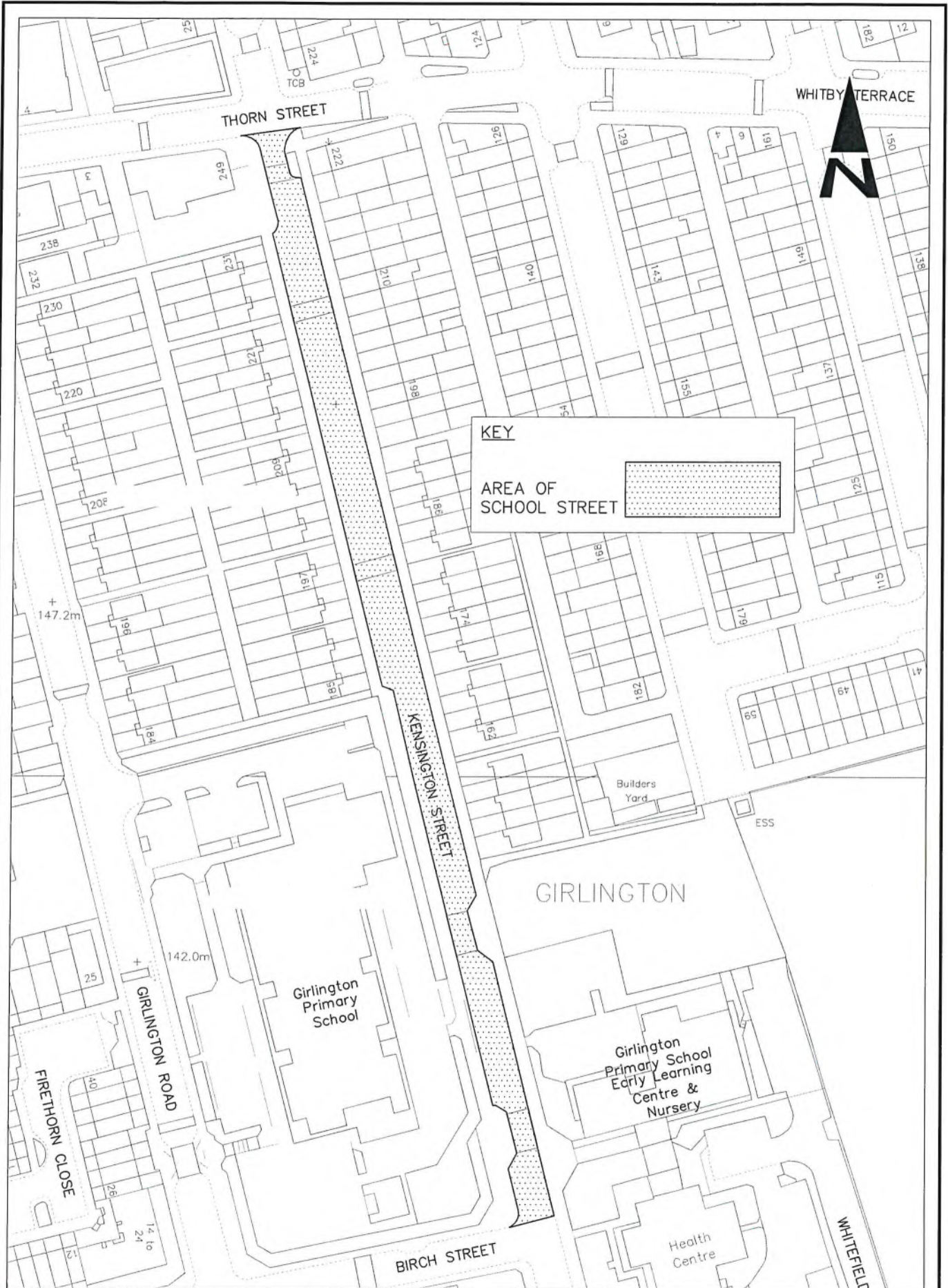


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
